Side Tilt Carriages

Side Tilt Carriages - Rated by the blade carriage lifting capability, there are actually four sizings of hook type tine carriages. The hook type tine carriages have been standardized.

The carriage bar spacing utilized for Class 1 is approximately 13 inches and the Class 1 carriage is rated to hold cargo as much as 2000lbs. The Class 2 carriage is rated to carry cargo up to 5,500lbs with carriage bar spacing of 16 inches. Class III carriages are rated for loads up to 10,000 lbs. The carriage bar spacing for this particular class is 20 inches. Class IV carriages are rated for cargo as much as 15,500 lbs. The carriage bar spacing utilized for this capacity is twenty five inches.

The carriages for pin type forks can be different depending on the manufacturer. Pin mounted forks could vary by the amount of offset between the tine eye and the fork. Carriage capacity will be determined by the carriage pin size and by the fork size.
